

A Biography of Daniel Goldstein

Daniel Goldstein is the founder and director of **Jewels of Judaism Publishing and Sabbath Hosting** in Jerusalem, Israel. Daniel was born in the USA and was raised in the state of New Jersey knowing that he is Jewish but he lived disconnected from traditional Judaism at that time. It was only during his university training when Daniel spent a semester abroad studying in Jerusalem that he became more connected with his Jewish heritage.

Daniel completed a Bachelor's degree in History and Bible and then went on to complete a Master's degree in Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL) with a minor in Islamic. After completing his university degrees and spending five years in the country of Turkey, Daniel immigrated to the state of Israel where he has been residing ever since. When God called Daniel to immigrate to Israel in the year 2007, God gave him a very specific calling: **"to take the precious out of the worthless,"** (Jeremiah 15:19).



Daniel struggled to understand this calling at first, however, during his first year in Israel God began to show Daniel that there are many precious Jewels that are hidden in Judaism, in Jewish tradition, and in the Hebrew text of the Bible that need to be taught to the Christian community around the world in order to have a cultural and historical depth of the Bible which is more accurate, especially as it relates to Yeshua the Messiah. Daniel has been seeking to fulfill this specific calling of **"taking the precious out of the worthless"** during the past twelve years that he has been living in Israel.

Daniel spent his first few years in Israel fully devoted to learning the Hebrew language along with studying Judaism and Jewish tradition. It was during this time that Daniel wrote and published his first book titled **Practicing the Sabbath with Community**. Daniel has been teaching about the Sabbath and the Jewish roots of the Christian faith ever since.

In 2018 Daniel published his second book titled **The Third Temple: A Sign of The Coming Messiah**. The goal of his second book is to provide a biblical and historical perspective of Jerusalem and the Jewish Temples while providing clear teaching about the last days with special emphasis on the prophecies regarding the Third Temple and the Second Coming of the Messiah. Daniel also ties these subjects together to provide a biblical understanding of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

Daniel currently lives in Jerusalem where he actively teaches the Bible with a specific emphasis on the Hebrew language and Jewish culture. Daniel also writes a weekly commentary explaining the Jewish roots of the Christian faith and hosts Christian tourists for the weekly Sabbath Experience as well as the biblical feasts throughout the year.
